End of restrictions

- End of the obligation to wear FFP2 masks (from 16.4.2022)
- Removal of the 3G rule for check-in (no more proof of vaccination, recovery or testing)
- No more guest registration for COVID-19 contact tracing
- Removal of the curfew
- However, our COVID-19 prevention concepts remain in place

Behaviour for guests in accommodation facilities

- 1. Wearing an **FFP2 mask** in public areas is **recommended** (not mandatory)
- 2. If possible, keep **distance of 2 m (6.6 ft)** to other guest groups
- 3. Reserve in advance if possible. Reduce congestion at reception and in the restaurant.
- 4. Pay contactless if possible. Preferably settle the invoice with a card.
- 5. Please follow the instructions of the employees.
- 6. Avoid shaking hands and hugs.
- 7. Wash hands several times a day with soap and water for at least 30 seconds.
- 8. Avoid touching the face with uncleaned hands.
- 9. Sneeze or cough into the crook of your arm or into a handkerchief.
- 10. Do not travel if there are signs of illness. If there are any signs during your stay, contact the reception.

Events & gatherings from 16.4.2022

• For events (meetings) with more than 500 participants, it is mandatory for the event manager to nominate a COVID-19 officer and to develop a COVID-19 prevention concept.

Entry requirements to Austria

- Since February 22, 2022, the **3-G rule applies to entry from all countries (Vaccinated, Recovered, Tested)**
 - Vaccination certificate (up to 365 days) valid from: second vaccination; 21 days after vaccination with 1 dose vaccine; booster vaccination; Vaccination after recovery
 - **Proof of recovery** (up to 180 days)
 - **Test proof:** PCR test (valid for 72 hours), antigen test not intended for personal use (valid for 24 hours)
- If no 3-G proof is available, registration for <u>pre-travel clearance</u> must be carried out and a ten-day quarantine must be initiated immediately, which is deemed to have ended once a negative test proof has been presented.
- Children up to the age of 12 are exempt from the obligation to provide evidence.
